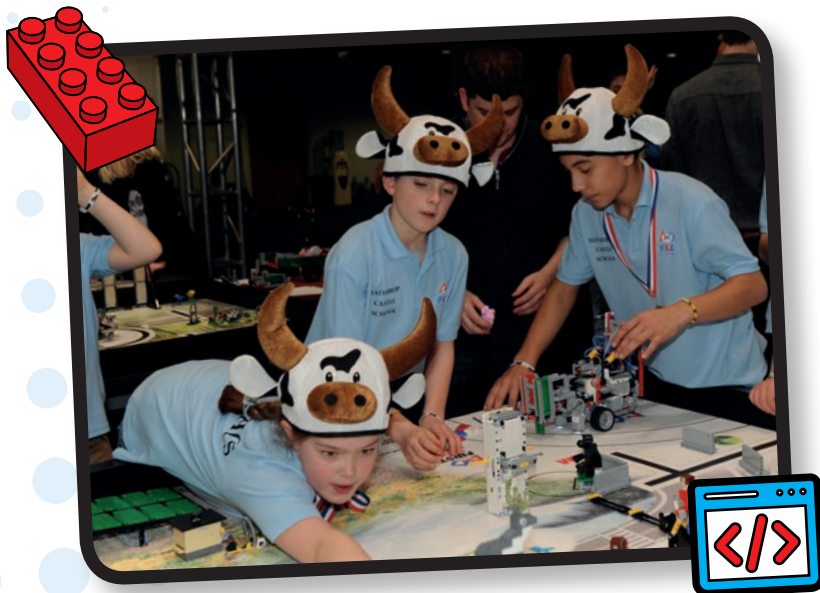

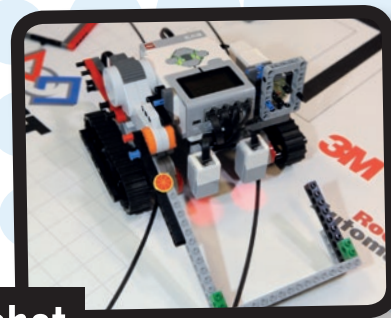
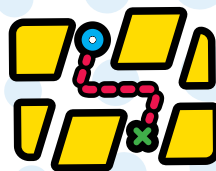
Run free with your robot mission

Show us what your robot can do!

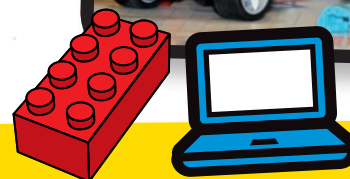


Solution snapshot

Enter in three easy steps:

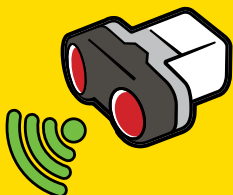
